## ***FAA Part 141 – Robinson R-22 VA Course Catalog***

Northeast Helicopters and the Veterans Administration (VA) have enjoyed a working relationship for over 25 years. Students wanting to utilize their Montgomery GI Bill benefits must attend a flight school that is an approved FAA Part 141 school, and keep a current FAA Class I or Class II medical at all times.

The student must pay for their Private Pilot Course or Private Pilot Add-On Course on their own. The VA will not reimburse students for the cost of these Courses.

### **NEH Enrollment Procedures:**

If you are a new student enrolling at NEH, you will be required to enroll with the owner, Rhonda Boulette and supply her with the following documentation before your first day of training:

- a) an original US birth certificate (must be the original) or a valid US passport
- b) Valid drivers license or a photo ID
- c) Your current medical certificate

These items will be kept on record for 5 years at NEH for TSA (Transportation Security Awareness) purposes.

Please remember, all of these items will need to be complete before your training begins.

*Prior to enrollment in this course, the student must hold a Private Pilot Certificate.*

**Commercial Add-On Course: (Fixed wing pilots transitioning to Rotorcraft)**

*Prior to enrollment in this course, the student must hold a Commercial Pilot Certification or Airline Transport Pilot Certificate issued by the Federal Aviation Administration. In addition, the student must have logged at least five (5) hours of instrument flight training.*

*Prior to enrollment in this course, the student must hold a Private Pilot Certificate with Rotorcraft Category and Helicopter Class Rating. VA benefits are authorized for this course concurrently with the Commercial Pilot Certificate.*

**Airline Transport Pilot Certification Course:**

**Enrollment Requirements:**

*Prior to enrollment in this course a student must:*

- a) Meet the aeronautical experience requirements prescribed in Subpart G of FAR 61 for an Airline Transport Certificate with a Rotorcraft Category and Helicopter Class Rating.*
- b) Hold at least a Commercial Pilot Certification and Instrument Rating; or*
- c) Meet the military pilot requirements under FAR 61.73 to qualify for a Commercial Pilot Certificate and Instrument Rating if the person is a rated military pilot or former rated military pilot of an Armed Force of the United States; or*
- d) Hold either a foreign Airline Transport Pilot license or foreign Commercial Pilot license issued by a contracting State to the Convention on International Civil Aviation.*
- e) Hold an FAA issued current class I medical certificate*
